

Amendment to the By-Laws of the
South Carolina Elks Association

Proposed Amendment 2023-2

Currently reads:

5.14 Elk Hall of Fame Committee

The Chairman of the Board of Directors, with prior approval of the Board, shall appoint to this Committee five Past State Presidents, each of whom shall have attended not less than three (3) summer meetings of the Association out of the five (5) next preceding annual summer meetings.

It shall be the responsibility of the Committee to select and induct into the Hall of Fame only those members of this Association who have distinguished themselves through long, arduous service and dedication to this Association and the principles of our Order.

The Committee shall report the name of the member selected for induction, if any, at the summer meeting, at which appropriate recognition and award will be presented.

Proposed change:

5.14 Elk Hall of Fame Committee

The Chairman of the Board of Directors, with prior approval of the Board, shall appoint to this Committee a Chairperson to solicit approval from the current members of the Hall of Fame to consider the applications for inclusion in the Hall of Fame.

Nominations must be made by members in good standing who are members of the Hall of Fame.

It shall be the responsibility of the Committee to select and induct into the Hall of Fame only those members of this Association who have distinguished themselves through long, arduous service and dedication to this Association and the principles of our Order.

The Committee shall report the name of the member selected for induction, if any, at the summer meeting, at which appropriate recognition and award will be presented.

Reason: It will eventually become difficult to find Past State Presidents who meet the criteria for participation. The decision about whom should be inducted can be determined by Elks who are already members of the Hall of Fame.
